

Team Manager (TM):

The TM is responsible for the communication from the office to reach the team.

By signing up as the TM and registering the team, please ensure you have read your role responsibilities in the Competition Regulations.

MySideline/Registration Process:

Once the team has registered, players can now register to the team on MySideline. Refer to the “How to guide to registering as an individual”.

Players must be registered to the team to be covered by insurance.

If a player can't register, they need to submit a support ticket to MySideline IT. This can be done by selecting the green help bubble at the bottom of the page.

Please note: You as Team Manager must also register to the team as a player.

Squad Registrations:

The TM will be able to view the registered players to the team at any time throughout the season once, PT gives the team access. The TM will be given access to “My Members” This can be viewed on your mobile phone or desktop. Please refer to the “Team Managers My Members” document. <https://manager.mysideline.com.au/login>

MySideline Game Times:

MySideline is used nationally which means the location you are viewing from will be of that time zone. For example, QLD game time is 7:00pm, although if viewed in NSW with daylight savings, it will show 8:00pm. Please ensure you are aware of this to avoid incorrect game time.

Draw Release

We aim to have this released Friday prior to games commencing. Team Managers will be notified once the draw is published. Initially only Round 1 is released due to the number of late changes, registrations and pull outs. Then Round 2 & 3 will be published. After grading Rounds 4 – 11 will then be released.

Free Game Ball

All teams receive a free ball at Round 1 which the TM can collect from the Venue Organiser. We do not replace balls, please write the team's name on the ball.

Grading

Teams are graded after R3. Pool 1 (B grade) is our most competitive competitions and Pool 4 (D grade) is our most social competition. Any grading requests must be submitted in writing to the office before Round 3 to be taken into consideration. After grading has occurred changes are unlikely.

Rules

PT use the TFA 8th edition rules. Our competition is 7 a-side. If a team wishes to play 6 a-side the opposing team and referee will need to agree to permit play.

We play through light and heavy rain. We may need to cancel games due to severe weather conditions or if the venue has closed due to water logged fields.

Pass the number above to your team mates to also check this prior to the games commencing. It is the TMs responsibility to check this line.

Facebook and our website will be updated once a decision has been made. NO texts messages or emails will be sent to TMs.

Forfeit Games

TMs must notify the Competition Manager of a forfeited game by 3pm of game day. Multiple forfeits after 3pm will see the team removed from the competition. Please refer to the Competition Regulations - <https://premiertouch.com.au/document-policies/>.

***If you are no longer able to manage the team, notify the office with the new TM details (Name, contact number and email). Premier Touch will require the new contact to confirm that they are taking over the TM responsibilities, including the invoice being re-sent under their name.**

Uniforms

All team shirts must be matching in colour with visible numbers on the back. This will be enforced by referees at the venue after round 4. Players may not be able to take the field after round 4 if they are not wearing the correct attire.

Referees

Injuries – All injuries must be reported on the night to the on-field referee. The injured player can find more details on our website <https://premiertouch.com.au/insurance-2/>. The player has 30 days from the date of injury to submit a claim form from Sportscover.

Special requests must be submitted via e-mail to office@premiertouch.com.au. Only once your special request has been confirmed by the office via e-mail has your request been entered. We cannot grant certain time slots, but we will do our very best to accommodate. Please note that according to the competition regulations requests only need to be met for 70% of the season and that requests are a privilege not a right. Only one request per team.

Behaviour - Premier Touch is a social competition and all players when they sign on agree to abide by Premier's player code of conduct.

Players must refrain from:

20.1 (a) continual breaches of the Laws of the game

20.1 (b) swearing, foul, abusive or derogatory language which includes comments, words or actions;

20.1 (c) verbal abuse including language, comments or words that threaten or denigrates a players, game referee or spectator on the basis of his/her religion, sexual orientation, disability, race, colour, national or ethnic origin;

20.1 (d) talking back to or arguing with a Game Referee

20.1 (e) dissent or disapproval towards a Game Referee following a decision by the Game Referee;

20.1 (f) Intentional physical contact not permitted by the rules or fighting with a player, game referee, spectator or Touch representative.

20.1 (g) excessively hard touches

20.1 (i) an action deemed, in the ultimate discretion of the Game Referee, Venue Organiser or Competition Manager, to bring the game into disrepute.
